Example - Westery edge of Turning Island

Easterly grid reference: Locate west edge of square in which point is situated and note corresponding figure to this line.....71  
Estimate tenths of the square from this line easterly to the point....8

Northerly grid reference: Locate south edge of square in which point is situated and note corresponding figure to this line.....93  
Estimate tenths of the square from this line northerly to the point....2

GRID REFERENCE (to nearest 100m).....718932

The grid reference should be prefixed with a zone number indicated above this column.
